**RE: NANUQ PROJECT – 2BE-NAN1823 ANNUAL WATER USE – CALENDAR YEAR 2019**

---

In September 2018, Peregrine Diamonds Ltd. (Peregrine) was purchased by De Beers Canada Inc. (De Beers). Peregrine is now a wholly owned subsidiary of De Beers.

Peregrine currently holds water use licence 2BE-NAN1823. The annual water use fee for this water use licence is \$219.00 based upon fees set out in Section 12(1)(b) of the Nunavut Waters Regulations (SOR/2016-69).

**Maximum water allocation** = 60 m<sup>3</sup> per day  
**Total days in the year** = 365  
**Charge per cubic meter** = \$0.01 per m<sup>3</sup>  
**Total annual fee:** \$219.00 (60m<sup>3</sup> x 365 days x \$0.01 per m<sup>3</sup>)

Peregrine paid the 2019 annual water use fee and the 2020 water use fee by credit card on December 4, 2019. The CIRNAC receipt number is 11241.

No field work was undertaken in 2019. Only one camp (Nanuq Camp) is located on the project. No fuel is stored at the camp or cached at the project.
