In September 2018, Peregrine Diamonds Ltd. (Peregrine) was purchased by De Beers Canada Inc. (De Beers). Peregrine is now a wholly owned subsidiary of De Beers.

Peregrine currently holds water use licence 2BE-NAN1823. The annual water use fee for this water use licence is \$219.00 based upon fees set out in Section 12(1)(b) of the Nunavut Waters Regulations (SOR/2016-69).

Maximum water allocation = 60 m³ per day Total days in the year = 365 Charge per cubic meter = \$0.01 per m³ **Total annual fee:** \$219.00 (60m³ x 365 days x \$0.01 per m³)

No field work was undertaken in 2021. Only one camp (Nanuq Camp) is located on the project. No fuel is stored at the camp or cached at the project.
