The camp will have the following petroleum products on site:

Jet B will be stored in standard 205L sealed fuel drums.

Gasoline will be stored in CSA approved 19L jerry cans

White gas will be stored in original containers

Propane will be stored in CSA approved 100 lb pressurized cylinders and stored according to MSDS requirements

In the event of a spill of petroleum products
 Attempts will be made to contain, recover, clean-up, or dispose of products and contaminated materials. Three spill kits will be in camp: Kitchen, Generator station and Helicopter refueling area.
