Dear Ms. Beaulieu,

Enclosed find the necessary forms and application fee for a Water License to cover the Noomut Project, in the Henik Lakes area of Kivalliq, Nunavut. The project will be operated by Complex Minerals Corp in association with Placer Dome (CLA) Limited. The project involves mineral exploration work including surface geophysical surveys and diamond drilling. The project has already been reviewed by the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC), the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB), Fisheries and Oceans Canada and the community of Arviat, NU. KIA Land Use License KVL302C252 was issued in the spring of 2002 and covers land use activities for the project until May 4, 2004. In support of the application, I have included, in addition to the requisite maps and Spill Response Plan, correspondence from the above agencies that pertain to the granting of Land Use License KVL302C252. This includes copies of;

- Existing KIA Land Use License KVL302C252 - expiring May 4, 2004 and covering the Noomut Project, along with the submitted project description
- The project brief with translation.
- The \$30 application fee.
- The Fisheries and Oceans review letter (their file NU00511) signed by Stephannie Thompson
- The NIRB questionnaire (their file 02EN049) signed by David Sateanna
- The NPC questionnaire signed by Brian Aglukark
- The WCB Operational Health and Safety plan authorized by Sylvester Wong.

It is our intention to mobilize into the Sandy Lake Camp to initiate work around June 10, 2003. We plan to begin drilling around June 25, 2003.
