



**FINAL ABANDONEMENT AND RESTORATION REPORT – Mineral Exploration, NTI Project, NU  
NUNAVUT WATER BOARD LICENSE TYPE “B” 2BE-NTI0507**

***Water License Term: Issued - July 5, 2005 Expired - July 31, 2007 (2 years)***

In March, 2003, Strongbow Resources Inc. (Strongbow) and Nunavut Tunngavik Incorporated (NTI) announced the completion of Exploration Agreement STBW-03-01, under which Strongbow may explore 604,723 ha of Inuit Owned Lands (IOL) in 28 non-contiguous parcels (the “NTI properties”) within the West Kitikmeot region of Nunavut. By 2005, Strongbow had reduced its land holdings to 149,706.70 ha over 15 parcels. The agreement is based on a Memorandum of Understanding signed in August 2002 that outlined the terms under which Strongbow can acquire and maintain the right to explore for minerals and develop mining operations on any or all of the NTI properties. In May, 2004, Strongbow changed its name to Strongbow Exploration Inc.

Strong Exploration Inc. (“Strongbow”) is a mineral exploration company dedicated to exploring for economic mineral deposits in Canada. North Arrow conducts extensive exploration programs within Nunavut and the Northwest Territories. We recognize the importance of our role in discovering mineral deposits and that our exploration programs must be conducted in the most socially and environmentally responsible fashion possible.

In 2005 Strongbow worked out of the Lupin Mine (not covered under the authority of this license) and conducted one half-day of till sampling within the land use area. Since 2005, Strongbow has not conducted work under the authority of this water licence – hence no abandonment measures are required.
