Further to our letter dated March 11, 2009, this will confirm that the above land use permit is hereby amended to include the work outlined in your request. All conditions annexed to land use permit N2008C0006 will apply to this amendment; as well as the following:

- 1. The Permittee shall locate all camps on gravel, sand or other durable land.
- 2. The Permittee shall not locate any sump within thirty one (31) metres of the normal high water mark of any stream.
- 3. The Permittee shall backfill and restore all sumps prior to the expiry date of this permit.
- 4. a) The Permittee shall, where flowing water from bore holes is encountered, plug the bore hole in such a manner as to permanently prevent any further outflow of water.
 - b) The artesian occurrence shall be reported to the Engineer within forty-eight (48) hours.



In addition, the Manitoba Denesuliné also recommend;

5. The Permittee shall submit to INAC at the end of their 2009 summer program, a report which includes the number of big game animal sightings (including wolves, barren ground grizzly and muskox) encountered. This report will include; time, date, location and number of sightings.
