Dear Mr. Zaluski

The Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") would like to acknowledge receipt on April 21, 2008 of the above document submitted under Part F, Item 1 of Licence 2BE-NUE0810. After an internal technical review of the Uranium Exploration Plan, the document was deemed to be insufficient in meeting the requirements set out in the Licence and a revision is hereby requested. The licensee shall resubmit the plan within 30 days to address the following deficiencies:

- 1. The uranium exploration plan should be a stand-alone document that is site-specific.
- 2. Part 6 in the submitted document references Saskatchewan regulatory documents- Nunavut regulations should be considered as opposed to those of Saskatchewan.
- 3. The plan should discuss uranium exploration with special attention paid to drilling, extraction and storage procedures as well as the process for remediating contaminated sites.
- 4. The plan should have a title page and a table of contents. It should identify the project's location, name and the date of the plan's creation. The plan should also identify the document's creator and the length of its effective period.
- 5. A map should be included identifying the drill core storage areas and drill sites relative to water features.
- 6. A plan should be discussed for the monitoring and inspection of drill sites and drill core storage areas.
