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Exploration Commences - Aberdeen Project - Forum Energy Metals

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Hi everyone,

I hope this email finds everyone well. This is just to notify you that Forum Energy Metals will be officially beginning its 2024 exploration program starting tomorrow on our Aberdeen Project. We are hoping to have 1 diamond drill running tomorrow, with the second one hopefully by the following week. Ground geophysics will begin in July for about a month (ground gravity). We plan to be drilling until middle September or so, possibly until the start of October if the weather holds.

We are planning about 30 drill holes at Tatiggaq and about 10 holes in a few other grids on the project (Ned, Bjorn, Qavvik, Ayra) for a total of hopefully 10,000 m.

We have mostly finished our camp construction at Aberdeen Lake. We will house between 20 and 30 people for most of the summer. We have 2 helicopters on site, which mostly fly between our camp on Aberdeen Lake at our main drill site near Gerhard Lake (Tatiggaq). Most re-supply and crew changes are by the single Otter out of Baker Lake, which are a few days per week.

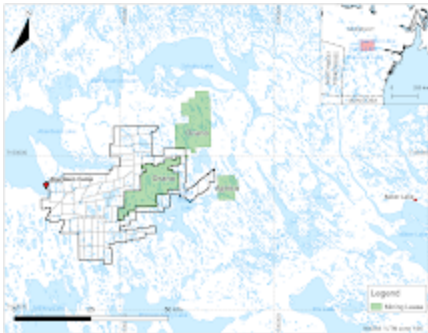
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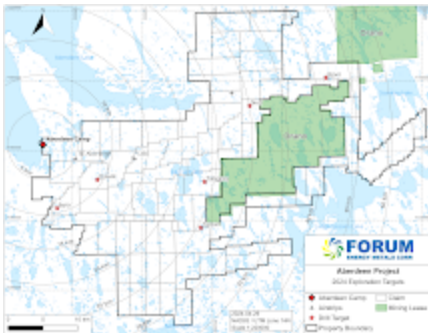
