## A. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

On June 28, 2012 the Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) distributed a water licence amendment application that was submitted by Northquest Ltd. to interested parties for review. Northquest Ltd. has requested an increase in their water use allowance for mineral exploration drilling purposes from 85 cubic metres per day to 120 cubic meters per day. This will facilitate the use of a second drill that will be used to evaluate a new target identified as "C7." Domestic water use will remain at 1 cubic metre per day. In total, Northquest Ltd. are requesting the use of 121 cubic metres per day to support the operations of their project.

## **B. RESULTS OF REVIEW**

On behalf of Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC), the following comments/ recommendations are submitted for the Board's consideration,

- AANDC has no issue with the submitted amendment application provided that all remaining terms and conditions of the licence still apply.
- Northquest Ltd. should ensure that the additional drill rig is equipped with a spill response kit and that their Spill Contingency Plan is revised to reflect this information.
