Dear Ida:

Attached, are my comments.

Item 2: We now take cardboard to the Whale Cove dump to be burned, rather than burning it on site. Waste oil is shipped to Arviat for incineration in their town waste oil incinerator.

Item 3: I will alter the plan.

Item 4: I will send another map if you require it

Item 6: The 5 gallon bucket is still stored in camp.

Item 7: The largest size for any drilling or lubricating fluid is 5 gallons. If a spill occurs, we will place the contaminated soil in another bucket and burn it on site.

Spilled salt will be picked up and used to make brine.

Item 8: Spill kits are located at the fuel berms and at the helicopter refueling site.

Item 10: The 5 gallon bucket of contaminated sand will be burned on site in a burning barrel rather than being taken to Whale Cove.

I trust that this will clarify any concerns.
