Work at the locations indicated on the water licence ended in 2007 and Licence expired on August 1, 2012.

8. ABANDONMENT MEASURES

Sample holes were backfilled; no other land disturbance or stream disturbance occurred during the program.

All materials were removed from the sites used at the end of the 2007 season. Fuel drums were flown out by air charter, all samples and sampling gear were air lifted to Resolute and sent via sealift and truck to our warehouse facility.

All sites were inspected to ensure no litter was left behind.
