Re: Application Cancellation of Water License 2BE-PCD0812 – Prince of Wales, Chartrand Lake, Cornwallis Island and Devon Island Projects.

Please find enclosed an application to cancel the above mentioned water license which expired August 1, 2012 as well as a cheque in the amount of \$30.00 for the cancellation fee. I have also included a copy of the inspection report from July of 2013, the Annual Reports for 2008 to 2012, the Annual Report letter sent to the NWB in 2008 regarding activities during the 2007 field season, three photographs showing closed sample holes and sample sites and an email from the Early Exploration Manager sent to the NWB in 2010 confirming that no work was completed in the years 2008 to 2010 and listings of Prospecting Permits issued for the area.

This project was completed in 2007 and no activities took place during any of the last 6 field seasons for any of the properties listed on the License.

Remediation was completed at the end of the 2007 field season when all fuel drums were flown out by air charter, all samples and sampling gear were air lifted to Resolute and sent via sealift and truck to our warehouse facility.

Also enclosed is a copy of the Water Fee Tool as provided by your office and a cheque for the required Water Fees of \$478.80

The licensee respectfully requests that the above named license be cancelled.
