This letter is to advise the Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") that Advanced Explorations Inc. ("AEI") would like to withdraw its new application (filed February 26, 2010) for a water license as it relates to a proposed exploration camp located on the Roche Bay project, Melville Peninsula, Nunavut, and specifically within the Qikiqtani Inuit Association region.

This new application was originally submitted in anticipation of conducting full season of exploration activities at the Roche Bay project in 2010 and 2011. At that time AEI also planned on moving part of its existing exploration camp to a location at the base of the Peninsula onto Crown lands, which would necessitate water taking at this new location. However, no exploration program was possible in 2010.

We understand that our current license (# 2BE-RBP0811) granted by the NWB already covers the area of the proposed new camp, and expires in 2011. As a result we have decided to withdraw the new application and amend the existing license for the upcoming exploration seasons to account for our water needs, and advise that an application to amend the license will be forwarded to NWB in the near future.
