Non-technical Project Summary to Accompany Land Use Licence Application

Ashton Mining (Northwest Territories) Ltd. is a mineral exploration company looking for diamonds in Nunavut. Ashton would like to obtain permission from the Kitikmeot Inuit Association to construct a fly-camp on Inuit Owned Land Parcel BB-16.

The camp will consist of five tents, an outhouse and a generator. It will be used for the month of August then put into storage for the rest of the year. Six people will be living at the camp during the month of August.

The impact of the camp on the environment is estimated to be minimal. Ashton understands that we are requesting permission to access privately owned land and, as a result, will obey all land use terms and conditions set out by the Kitikmeot Inuit Association.
