

This license authorizes water use (not to exceed 5 cubic meters a day) and waste disposal in association with a temporary fly camp that was planned to be constructed on Inuit Owned Land Parcel BB-16. The camp was to consist of five canvas prospector's tents with wooden floors and was to occupy a footprint that would not exceed 130m².

The fly camp described in the application was never constructed.

As no water use or waste disposal was conducted under the authority of this license during its five year term there are no reclamation activities to report.
