## A. BACKGROUND

Parker Lake Project is located in the Kivalliq Region of Nunavut, closest to the Inuit communities of Rankin Inlet and Baker Lake. Inuit have lived and travelled the lands and waters in this area for thousands of years. The 2BE-PKR1621 license is located in the Baker Lake and Chesterfield Inlet Watersheds – 8 and 10.

Parker Lake Project is a Type B license for the proponent Agnico-Eagle Mines Ltd. The proponent is applying for a renewal of this license. This is an exploration camp at Parker Lake and Cone Hill. The water will be used for drilling and camp purposes.

CIRNAC provides the following comments and recommendations pertaining to the application package. A summary of the subjects of recommendations can be found in Table 1. ## **RESULTS OF REVIEW** Α.

CIRNAC has reviewed the license renewal for 2BE-PKR1621 and has found that the license renewal is in order since the proponent has not made any changes to the water use and disposal described in the 2BE-PKR1621 license issued March 7, 2016. CIRNAC acknowledges the amalgamation of Parentco into Agnico Eagle Mines Ltd. CIRNAC therefor has no comments or recommendations.
