Dear Mr. Frenette:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) has completed a technical review of Annual Report submissions for the above stated Water Licences (Licences).

On December 06, 2018, the Board acknowledged receipt of the 2018 Annual Report and additional associated information for Water Licence No. 2BE-PKR1621 and made them available to the Kivalliq distribution list for information. Similarly, on December 12, 2016, November 24, 2017, and December 23, 2018 the NWB acknowledged receipt of the respective 2016, 2017 and 2018 Annual Reports for Water Licence No. 2BE-PTR1621 and provided them to the Kivalliq distribution list for information. No comments have been received to date.

The technical review of the Annual Reports determined that the information provided generally addresses the requirements of the above stated Water Licences.

The Board notes that the updated Spill Contingency Plan entitled "Parker Lake, Peter Lake, Fox Lake and Cone Hill Exploration Projects Spill Contingency Plan" dated September 2017 (Plan) was submitted to the NWB on September 27, 2017 to satisfy the requirement of Part H, Item 1 of both Licences and is applicable to both Licences. The Plan was previously reviewed by interested parties. No concerns were identified and submitted to the Board regarding this Plan.

The technical review of this Plan found it to be complete and meeting the requirements of current Water Licences. The Board appreciates submission of detailed reports on decontamination activities related to spills occurred in 2017.
