## Parker Lake Project Closure and Reclamation Plan

Proposed exploration activities at the Parker Lake Project are supported from the Meadowbank Exploration Camp. Personnel are flown to the property on a daily basis by helicopter, eliminating the need for any structures to be built at the project site. The proposed exploration program is seasonal; the following closure and reclamation activities will occur by the end of each field season.

All drill sites will be reclaimed as follows:

- Drill casing will be removed.
- Area will be restored as required to match natural conditions.

The fuel caches will be dismantled.

All equipment and materials (drill rig, drill core, spill kits, fuel drums etc.) will be removed from the project site and returned to the Meadowbank Exploration Camp by helicopter. Any solid waste will be disposed of at the Meadowbank Mine Site facilities.
