Good morning Garth,

I am in the process of getting your application for amendment finalized and to the Board members for approval and just wanted to confirm a few things.

In your application, I couldn't find anywhere that it actually stated what was being requested in the amendment. What I needed to do was go through the details and compare with what the original application was for and what was covered in the current Licence.

What I have things narrowed down to in the application are:

- 1) addition of the drilling component as 2BE-QAM0608 does not allow for drilling; and
- 2) increase in the amount of water use to allow for the 55m³/day required in drilling; total would now be 60m³/day max.

The application also does not include lats/longs for the project itself. Map2 gives a good location of the overall project, however the coord. are UTM and for no better reason than not having the ability (or knowledge) to convert, I don't have the lats/longs. Could you provide those. my rough guess is in the area of 64-65N and 97.5-99W.

Other than the above, if there is anything else that needs consideration for the amendment, please let me know. I am hoping to get this to the Board members this afternoon, which should see the Licence issued (assuming approval) by mid-next week. Please give the Phyllis or Richard a call (867-360-6338) to check on the progress next week.
