On page 7 of the Spill Contingency Plan, Table 2-Emergency Contacts, ECCC notes an incorrect contact number for ECCC, i.e. 867-766-3737. This number should be changed.

ECCC recommends that in the case of a spill or emergency, the 24 Hour Northwest Territories-Nunavut Spill Report Line should be contacted first by North Arrow Minerals Inc., who will then involve ECCC Emergencies when appropriate.
