North Arrow Minerals Inc. and Stornoway Diamond Corp. have an option agreement in place whereby North Arrow Minerals is the operator of the Qilalugaq Project.

General Background Information on the Project (*optional):

In July and August of 2014 a bulk sampling program was carried out by North Arrow Minerals Inc. at the Qilalugaq Project, which is located near Repulse Bay, NU. Approximately 1500 tonnes of material was extracted by trenching method from the Q1-4 kimberlite complex. Material was obtained using a small, helicopter portable mini-excavator. Sample bags were filled at the site and slung by helicopter back to an area in the Hamlet and shipped south via barge for processing. Due to the proximity of the project area to the Hamlet of Repulse Bay, camp facilities were not required, and crews were accommodated at housing facilities within the Hamlet. Fuel for the program was also stored within the Hamlet. No water was used by the Licensee during the bulk sample collection. All combustible and non-combustible waste (food, food containers, paper, wood, used excavator oil) and equipment was removed from the land use area at the end of the program via helicopter as per the Abandonment and Restoration plan for the Project. Upon completion of the program, the sample site was remediated and re-contoured, with no rock or soil stockpiles remaining at the site.
