Enclosed is a summary report on water use and water conservation practices at our Roche Bay drilling camp. As you can tell by our report, the scale of operations was smaller than we had anticipated in our previous request. As a result, we would like to amend our application to fit our best estimate of water use:

- Total water volume: 300 cubic meters per day; up to 5 water sources
- Total water for domestic purposes: 10 cubic meters per day; separate water source
- Total water for drilling purposes: 290 cubic meters per day; up to 4 water sources
- Desired expiry date for the Licence: October 2011

This letter supersedes any other forms for this application. If we anticipate that the total volume should be exceeded during the term of the licence we will submit an application for an amendment to the Nunavut Water Board.
