This letter is an addendum for the Abandonment and Restoration Plan to licence 2BE-RBP0608 in response to comments received from Nunavut Water Board in your October 31st letter.

In regards to plans for the camp electrical system at the time of final decommissioning, our plans are to fully disassemble and remove the system from the camp site at that time. No substantive artifacts are planned to be left over at the site after work is complete.

In regards to the plans for re-vegetation of the drill holes from the camp, our current policy (applied to the 2008 drilling season) is as follows:

- Drill sites are cleaned up immediately upon completion of drilling and removal of the drill rig.
- The sites are re-contoured using drill cuttings if required.
- Peat moss is then placed on the re-contoured surface to enhance the natural revegetation process.
- Progress of this re-vegetation is monitored during the next field season, with additional measures taken as needed.

If this treatment is insufficient, please contact us so that we can alter procedures accordingly.
