On behalf of the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development (DIAND), I have reviewed the 2005 Annual Report, submitted by Strongbow Exploration Inc. for the Regan Lake Project with respect to License NWB2REG0406 (License).

Part D, Item 5 of License states that the proponent shall contain all sewage in latrine pits located at least 30 meters above the ordinary high water mark of any water body. The item goes on to state; these latrine pits shall be treated with lime and covered with native material. It is unclear from the 2005 Annual Report if these actions were taken.

Also, the proponent should updated their Spill Contingency Plan to included Mr. Peter Kusugak, (867) 975-4295 as the INAC contact.
