This letter is being written in response to comments sent to your office by Mr. Stephen Bathory on behalf of the Department of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (DIAND) dated May 23, 2006, regarding the 2005 Annual Report submitted in accordance with Part B, Section 1 of the terms and conditions of the above referenced water use license.

In his correspondence Mr. Bathory has noted that it is unclear from the information provided in the report if latrine pits were dealt with as per Part D, Item 5 of NWB2REG0406. Please be advised that the minimal amount of sewage waste produced by the 5 personnel during their 8 day occupation of the camp was dealt with as per the terms and conditions of the license, and that in the future, Strongbow Exploration Inc. will endeavour to provide more detail of the abandonment and reclamation activities undertaken in their Annual Report submissions to the Nunavut Water Board.


Also please note that the Spill Contingency Plan for the Regan Lake Project will be updated to include Mr. Peter Kusugak as the INAC contact.
