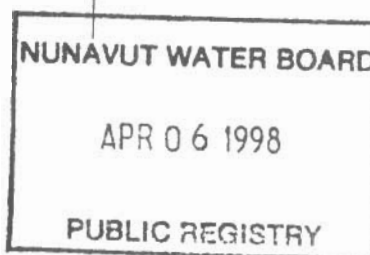

Peter, this note is to advise you that Monopros Limited will be conducting a small sediment sampling programme in the area of the southern Boothia Peninsula, sometime between late June and early August. As the operation will require less than 100 person-days, we have not applied for a land use permit. The project will consist of flying into the area selected, collecting 20-litre samples in pails by means of hand tools, then flying out again.

There will not be a camp associated with the sampling programme; the approximately 10 people required (geologists and helicopter crew) will seek accommodation in or around Gjoa Haven. A temporary fuel cache of about 10 drums will be set up in an area accessible to the sampling. The project is being run out of our office in Val d'Or, PQ, rather than out of our Yellowknife office.

Last year, we brought Jet-B fuel into Ursuqtuq (Gjoa Haven). It currently is stored with APM Construction. We intend to rotate in two full drums for field use for the helicopters and rotate out the same number of empties.

I have included with this FAX a rough sketch of the area we are interested in sampling.

I also shall advise the Nunavut Water Board, even though we will not be establishing a camp.

Thank you for the opportunity to advise District Office about our planned activities. Please let me know if you have any questions or concerns.
