Under water licence 2BE-SCH0712, Forum Uranium is not permitted any camp installations or operations; however, this camp is inactive. At the time of the inspection, there was no evidence that water was used or waste was deposited to water.								
During the inspection, 5 drill sites under the expired licence 2BE-SCH0712 were inspected (RD7-01, RW-01, GR-01, BD-01, BD-02). All drill sites appear to have been managed satisfactory as outlined in the licence except site BD-02. At this site, a drill collar was not cut								
and the hole was not permanently sealed. As part of remediation activities, drill collars must be removed and the holes must be								
capped with a permanent seal.
