On November 7, 2014 the NWB has received an email from Eva Paul's AANDC referred to the water Licence 2BE-SIL 0709 cancellation application. The email mentions a Report submitted by North Arrow Minerals to show the remediation work carried out in 2014, and recommends the Licensee to submit a copy to the Nunavut Water Board (NWB). The email also states that the licence may be cancelled as long as the NWB is satisfied that all the administrative requirements have been met.

In order to consider the Application for cancellation complete and proceed with the Licence cancellation, the NWB requires the following documents to be submitted:

- 1) A copy of the 2014 Remediation Work Report
- 2)

According to AANDC comments on the 2008 Annual Report, a spill occurred at site on March 4, 2008. The Applicant should submit all documentation regarding the disposal of the waste generated as a result of the spill including documents from the disposal site.

Once the requested documents have been submitted, the Board considers the Application for Cancellation complete and will proceed with the Cancellation.

Thanks for contacting me regarding this – I'll admit, it had gone off my radar somewhat as I thought we had submitted the requisite files to the NWB last fall, but I guess not (my apologies).

Attached please find a summary of our clean-up efforts at the Silvertip Project (2BE-SIL0709). The report includes a table with the locations we visited and removed debris (with coordinates), along with before and after pictures of all items noted in the inspection report(s). Also attached is a copy of the fuel spill reported in 2008. There was no documentation of the disposal site in Yellowknife, only that the contaminated materials were collected and shipped. Unfortunately this is a few years before my time here at North Arrow, so I don't know how much luck I might have finding this as this is an old project of the companies that is missing many things. Please let me know if what I have provided is satisfactory.
