RE: 2BE-SLA0814 Application for Cancellation – Golden Bull Resources Corp

Environment Canada (EC) has reviewed the above-mentioned request for cancellation submitted to the Nunavut Water Board (NWB). The following specialist advice has been provided pursuant to the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act*, Section 36(3) of the *Fisheries Act*, the *Migratory Birds Convention Act*, and the *Species at Risk Act*.

Golden Bull Resources Corp. has submitted to the NWB an application for the cancellation of water license 2BE-SLA0814 for their Slave Project. EC has no objections to the cancellation of the license as the proponent states that no undertakings have occurred under this license, no personnel or material were ever delivered to the property, and therefore has met all abandonment and restoration obligations as laid out in the water license.

If there are any changes in the project EC should be notified as further review may be necessary.
