SECTION 1 Comments Non-Compliance with Act or Licence Action Required					
Inspectors Statement					
On July 15 th 2014 a closure inspection was conducted for Land use permit N2007C0003 by Inspector Atuat Shouldice and Inspector Robert Savard. Stacks of core were visible from the air and sixteen tent rings/discolored earth.					
Inspectors walked the site and lake to where previous water supply intake was used.					
Stornoway Diamond Corporation has applied for closure of land use permit N2007C0003 and cancellation of water licence 2BE-					
SNN0813.					
SECTION 2 Non-Compliance with Act or Licence Action Required					
<u>N2007C0003</u>					
<u>Observations</u>					
Core boxes were stacked neat and tidy.					
 Camp site/ tent frames look to have been burnt down during site remediation. Coal and lumber still visible around some 					
tent rings and discoloration of earth where tent frames sat.					
No equipment, drums or debris were found on site as required in the Permit.					
The two drill sites noted above were left in a clean and close to natural state as possible. Cuttings were in a natural					
depression as required. No equipment or debris noted.

Closure Although open burning is not permitted, small pieces burnt lumber are still visible and in the Inspectors opinion will have little to effect on the environment.

Land Use Permit N2007C0003 is recommended for closure.

Water Licence 2BE-SNN0813 is recommended for cancellation.




Photo 1: Camp site, arrow indicating tent rings




Photo 2: Tent rings, arrow indication burnt lumber and coal.
