Re: Amendment Request for Nunavut Water Board Licence No. 2BE-STO1015

Dear Ms. Beaulieu,

Please accept this application for a renewal and amendment to the approved Nunavut Water Board (NWB) Licence No. 2BE-STO1015. Commander Resources Ltd. and Aston Bay Holdings have contracted APEX Geoscience Ltd. to act on their behalf with regard to the Aston Bay Property (formerly the Storm Property). Provisions in the existing licence address water use for a small, temporary exploration camp and diamond drilling activities within approved areas, held by Commander Resources Ltd.

Requested amendments to Licence No. 2BE-STO1015 include: a Property name change, a new camp location, an increase in the water usage for the drilling program and an extension to the expiry date.

The Property name has changed from the Storm Property to the Aston Bay Property, which encompasses the Storm and Seal Prospects. The proposal for a new camp location is due to the limitations of the previous camp site, including an airstrip that is too short. During the 2014 summer program the field crew scouted out the proposed new camp area, which would suit a longer, and therefore safer, air strip. Figures 1 and 2 show the location of the proposed new camp with respect to the Property boundaries, existing camp and diamond drilling areas. Figure 3 illustrates the proposed new camp layout with respect to the proposed water source, the Aston River.

The increase in the quantity of water used for the diamond drilling program is requested as the previously approved amount was deemed insufficient for the number and depth of the diamond drill holes proposed.

The renewal requests a five year extension on the existing licence.

The proposed changes will not affect the type of water use, quality of water used, or environmental considerations.


