



Re: Major General Resources - Spill Contingency Plan

The Water Resources Division has reviewed the Fuel Spill Contingency Plan (the "Plan") submitted by Major General Resources. In general, the Plan lacks sufficient detail and was not prepared in accordance with the NWT Water Board's "Guidelines for Contingency Planning" dated January 1987.

It is recommended that the Licensee resubmit the Plan utilizing the format outlined in the above-mentioned Guideline. Although the amount of fuel to be stored at this site is relatively small, it is important that staff are aware of the detailed steps to be taken after a spill has occurred. The Plan should outline the reporting procedure and action plan that will be implemented by staff at the site. In addition, a resource inventory should be included that describes the specific types of equipment available to respond to spills and the locations where the equipment and the responsible personnel are located.
