2. Galaxy Site: 70deg 29min 36secN 25 drums diesel

109deg 50min 36secW 20drums Jet A

3. Eider Site: 70deg 43min 27secN 25 drums diesel

109deg 49min 24secW 20 drums JetA

Each cache location will contain a spill kit, have at least one extra fuel storage container on site equal to or greater than the size of the largest fuel container and be established no closer to 31 metres of the normal high water mark of any stream or lake. All efforts will be made to cache drums on sandy subsurfaces (eskers) on flat topographic highs. All drums will be marked with Diamonds North's name. Please note that these caches are temporary and that all empties will be removed on an on-going basis through the life of the field program
