Richard,

As a result of poor drilling production during our 2007 exploration program Titan Uranium Inc. would like to apply for an extension to our License 2BE-THE608. The program being carried out in the area will be similar to that contained in the current license and Titan will adhere to all conditions annexed to the original license.

In addition, Titan would like to move the location of our camp some 900 metres to the south to a position closer to the landing area and fuel cache. This change of location was recommended by Andrew Kiem during his site visit last season. The move to a sandy area on the esker will alleviate all of the greywater concerns listed in the 2007 site visit report.
