Land Use Permit application regarding Itza Lake camp site, Nunavut.

Confirming your discussions with Mike McNeill, Mega Uranium Ltd. (Mega) proposes to complete the reclamation as outlined in: "The Abandonment and Restoration Plan, Thelon Project for Titan Uranium Inc.", dated September 12, 2006, revised January 18, 2010 (copy attached), specifically section 6 of the plan, with respect to the final abandonment and restoration of the Itza Lake camp site.

Mega does not propose to reuse this camp and does not propose any exploration activities based out of this camp site. Our main aim is to clean up and restore the camp site to its original state. In 2012 Mega held or had applied for, various mineral claims and mining leases previously held under the name of Titan Uranium Inc. (Titan). In December 2012 Mega sold its interests in these claims/leases to NexGen Energy Ltd. (NexGen) and consequently the Thelon Project is now the responsibility of NexGen.

Please could you advise us on any additional information you require for us to proceed with this plan. We would like to proceed with work no later than mid-March 2013.

With respect to the water board permit, Christine Wilson, Resource Management Officer, AANDC, has indicated that Mega is currently in compliance with water board requirements and that there are no outstanding issues at the site.

Mega is willing to assume responsibility for the Land Use Permit N2005C0040, issued to Titan (copy attached), specifically as it relates to the final abandonment and restoration of the Itza Lake camp site. Put another way, Mega is willing to assume responsibility and liability for the Itza Lake camp site as specified in Land Use Permit N2005C0040.
