<p><u>Background</u></p> <p>Mega Uranium Limited has requested to cancel their Water Licence 2BE-THE on December 12, 2013. Their 2013 Annual Report provides a summary of the remediation activities associated with the closure of their Itza Lake camp at GPS coordinates: 65°02'25"N and 98°22'26"W. On July 18, 2014 an inspection of their campsite was conducted to confirm that remediation was conducted according to their Abandonment and Restoration Plan and that no major obligations under their water licence remain.</p> <p><u>Observations on Site</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. No infrastructure remained on site, except for four core boxes now the property of NexGen Energy. 2. Wooden infrastructure appears to have been burned and there are small traces of ash on the ground. 3. No spills were observed during the inspection. 4. It appears that the ground has been contoured to a more natural state. <p><u>Inspector's Statement</u></p> <p>Based on the evidence made available to AANDC through correspondences, records, and site inspections, no concerns were noted with the site, and the project is recommended to proceed with cancellation.</p>
