On behalf of Environment Canada (EC), I have reviewed the information submitted as a requirement of Part H, Item 1 of water license 2BE-THE0608. The following specialist advice has been provided pursuant to Environment Canada's mandated responsibilities for the enforcement of the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act*, Section 36(3) of the *Fisheries Act*, the *Migratory Birds Convention Act*, and the *Species at Risk Act*.

Environment Canada has no concerns with Titan Uranium Inc. Spill Contingency Plan at this time. EC does however recommend that secondary containment or a surface liner (drip pans, fold-a-tanks, etc) be placed under all container or vehicle fuel tank inlet and outlet points, hose connections and hose ends during fuel or hazardous substance transfers. Secondary containment should be of adequate size and volume to contain and hold fluids for the purpose of preventing spills (the worst-case scenario).
