**Re: Licence No. 2BE-TIM0813, Type “B”; Cancellation Application by Diamondex Resources Ltd. for the Water Licence Issued to the Tim Project**

Dear Ms. Chadwick:

The Nunavut Water Board (the NWB or Board) has updated its most recent review of the application submitted by Diamondex Resources Ltd. for the cancellation of Water Licence No 2BE-TIM0813, which was issued to the Tim Project on August 27, 2008 and expired on June 27, 2013. The Tim Project is located approximately 90 kilometres northwest of Kugaaruk, in the Kitikmeot Region, Nunavut.

Similar to the previous review<sup>1</sup>, the updated review identified the absence of specific information required to complete the cancellation process for the licence including the following:

- Copies of annual reports for the period 2012 – 2015, as required under Part B, Item 2, or confirmation that no on-site or field activities were carried out during the aforementioned period;
- A copy of an addendum to the Spill Contingency Plan dated 2008, as required under Part H, Item 2 of the Licence terms and conditions; and
- A copy of the Abandonment and Restoration Plan required under Part I, Item 1 of the Licence' terms and conditions.
