**Subject: 2BE-TOR1014 – Type “B”; Cancellation Application by North Arrow Minerals for the Torp Lake Project**

Dear Mr. MacMorran:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) received on March 27, 2014, from North Arrow Minerals, an application and supporting information (Application) for the cancellation of a water licence issued to the Torp Lake (Project), which is located 245 kilometres Southeast of Kugluktuk and 86 Northwest of Bathurst Inlet in the Kitikmeot Region of Nunavut. The Licence for the Project was issued on January 7, 2010 and expired on December 31, 2014.

Following receipt, the NWB distributed the Application on April 29, 2014 for a thirty-day review period and and/or comment period following which submissions<sup>1</sup> were received from Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC)

The NWB reviewed the application and supporting information as well the final report<sup>2</sup> filed by the Inspector of Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development for the project while taking into consideration interveners' comments and/or recommendations.

The review determined that the application and associated information generally satisfied the requirements for cancellation of the Licence. Therefore, in accordance with s. 43(1) (c) (i) of *Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act (Act)*, the Board has hereby cancelled Licence ~~2BE-CGP1012~~ 2BE-TOR1014 under **Motion No. 2014-B1-017**. The Licensee should note, however, that consistent with s. 46 of the Act: “The expiry or cancellation of a licence does not relieve the holder from any obligations imposed by the licence.”
