The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Continue mineral exploration activities including surface mapping and geological sampling of the Turner Lake, TED, McAvoy Lake and Gela Lake ("TTMG") mineral claims in Nunavut.
2. Helicopter mobilization of staff to and from the mineral claims daily for the duration of the project activities.
3. Newly proposed activities include:
 - Deployment of a drill rig no greater than 5500kg for undertaking diamond drilling activities on the Turner and Ted Properties.
 - Collection of water from a local surface water sources to support drill rig activities.
4. Associated NPC File No: 149562
5. Location: Kitikmeot [Inuit Owned Lands].

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has determined that this project proposal is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan. The NPC has determined that the above-noted project proposal is a significant modification to

the project because of the deployment and use of a drill rig for undertaking diamond drilling on the Turner and Ted Properties.

The project proposal requires screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) because it does not belong to a class of exempt works or activities set out in Schedule 12-1 of the Nunavut Agreement.
