RE: TYPE 'B' WATER LICENCE NO. 2BE-TUK1015 – TUKTU PROJECT – ADVANCED EXPLORATIONS INC. – AMENDMENT CLARIFICATION

Dear Mrs. Beaulieu,

On May 30, 2011, the Nunavut Water Board approved the amendment requested for the Tuktu Project. The amendment included the daily water allowance provisions for domestic and drilling purposes be redistributed, changing the domestic water allowance from 3 mg per day to 10 mg per day and changing the drilling water allowance from 180 mg per day to 173 mg per day. The total water allowance did not change at 183 mg per day.

The Water Resources Regional Coordinator, INAC recommended that we clarify some inconsistencies within the overall company documentation. To clarify the statement that the domestic water is estimated to be a maximum of 7.5 m² per day, the anticipated number of people at camp has increased since that estimate was calculated. The additional people at camp increase the amount of domestic water used for cooking and general hygiene. To clarify the statement that only two (2) drills are planned, each using approximately 90 m² of water per day, there are still only two (2) drills. However, each drill is using less water than we originally anticipated. Each drill is using an estimated 54.5 m² of water per day including both day and night shifts when the drill is drilling for the full shifts. This would make the total for two (2) drills an estimated 109 m² per day.

I hope this helps clarify these inconsistencies.
