Victory asked about industry support in the region and discussed caribou mitigation measures. KIA voiced that the Rankin community in general and the KIA themselves are supportive of mineral exploration and mining, however the local HTO groups are not always supportive of mineral exploration due to declining caribou numbers and the perceived affect that helicopters and noise has on caribou migration and calving etc. Gabriel suggested that we call the local HTO to engage them and hear feedback.

Victory Exploration walked-through an introductory presentation about the proposed activities, stressing that this was low impact and very early stage and we will shut down all activities for two months during caribou calving from May 15 to July 15. Andre said that the area of interest was not administered by the Rankin Inlet HTO, that he was unable to provide any feedback, and instead we should talk to Whale Cove HTO. We reiterated that we were only looking for an introductory call for high-level feedback and to provide the opportunity for local groups to voice any immediate concerns, and that we would also like feedback from Rankin Inlet HTO. Brief feedback was that Andre was pleased with our proposed work program, and said that he felt comfortable that it was low impact. The proposed shutdown period was well received. No concerns over water quality or use were expressed.

The HTO members said that they weren't comfortable commenting on or providing feedback on any of the proposed plans as the entire HTO board was not present, and suggested we call back another time when all the members were present.
