A. RESULTS OF REVIEW

1.) Application

Comment: In reviewing the application, the application seems to be incomplete as box 6 "Nature of interest in the land" is not complete, in that, the applicant has indicated that they do not have any land use authorization from either the crown or the regional Inuit Association for this project.

Recommendation: CIRNAC recommends that the applicant have proper authorization to use the land before any water licence is issued.
