Further to the initial application submitted to your office regarding the above referenced licence number, please be advised of the following clarification to the location of the proposed camp.

In the original application for the amendment, four possible camp locations had been identified, however it has now been determined that the most likely location for the proposed camp will be in the proximity of the following coordinates:

If this location should change at any time due to logistical, geographical, or other concerns (i.e. archaeological findings) we will notify the Nunavut Water Board of the alternate location as soon as is practicable.
