On March 28, 2008 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received Savant Explorations Ltd.'s (Savant's) "Retort Lake – Yava Property Mining Exploration" project proposal from Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC). NIRB has assigned this project proposal file number **08EN034**.

Following a preliminary completeness check of this project proposal, on April 4, 2008 the NIRB requested additional information from Savant, to be submitted by April 25, 2008. The NIRB received the requested information on April 21, 2008.

Exploration activities conducted by Pacifica Resources Ltd. on the Yava property were previously screened by the NIRB in 2005 under NIRB File No. **05EN027**. The proposed project is located in the Kitikmeot Region, approximately 125 km SSW of the community of Kingoak (Bathurst Inlet). Savant proposes to conduct exploration activities from June 15 to September 5, 2008 and from June 1 to May 31, 2009.

The proposed project activities include:

- Establish a 12 person, 9 wall tent temporary exploration camp
- Temporary pier construction for docking of float plane
- Diamond drilling program with 10+ targets (2000-2500 m total)
- Helicopter support for drill rig and personnel movements
- Fuel storage at camp site



NIRB would like Parties to provide comments regarding:

- Whether the project proposal is likely to arouse significant public concern; and if so, why;
- Whether the project proposal is likely to cause significant adverse eco-systemic and socio-economic effects; and if so, why;
- Whether the project is of a type where the potential adverse effects are highly predictable and mitigable with known technology, (please provide any recommended mitigation measures); and
- Any matter of importance to the Party related to the project proposal.
