NOTE TO FILE:

Dave Stevenson with Wolfden Resources Inc. at the ULU site called with reference to the email he sent June 4, 2005.

I informed him that there was a letter prepared to go out and summarized the letter for him, telling him that Wolfden would not be authorized to do anything with the mine water other than circulate in the sump until such a time that a submission under Part D, Item 7 of the Licence was received and approved by the Board. He also was wondering about sampling and if it would have to be done. I told him that the parameters of the Licence under Part D would need to be met and what they would be doing should be part of the proposal to be sent in. I mentioned the concern with ammonia being present depending on what explosives are being used, also just the fact that the water is coming from underground where ammonia based explosives had been used in the past. After the conversation, I'd looked up the licence again and there's no requirement for sampling or a water quality limit for ammonia. I did notice however, that there was a requirement to sample for chorine at the two settling ponds?

On another topic, Dave had mentioned their wish to possibly change the coliform limit on their licence or have it removed altogether as they were looking at high values in the effluent. He said they had looked into some sort of chorine tablet for disinfection of the effluent but their consultants advised against it. I agreed with them and mentioned that chlorine in any form wasn't recommended for use, especially where ammonia may be present in other effluent streams (minewater). I suggested that he also look at submitting a request wrt the coliform requirements. I also mentioned that other exploration sites with sewage treatment plants have trouble with the F-coliform numbers.
