As outlined in the cover letter, these IFC drawings correspond to the engineering drawings provided to the NWB with the water licence amendment and renewal application earlier this year, and have been subject to public review and Board consideration; *“the only changes are the identification as being IFC, and the addition of the engineer’s seal, notes related to boundary limits and control points, and the listing of stakeout points.”*
