

COMMUNICATIONS BLACKOUT

In the event of a communications blackout, the primary hazard is isolation.

Communication sources on site are phones, vehicle, aviation and short wave radios. These are kept in separate locations in the building - control room and radio room.

Contact would be made with the Lupin minesite or through northern communities to advise them of the situation and assist as required.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES - ULU

COMMUNICATIONS BLACKOUT

In the event of a communications blackout, the following procedures will be followed:

1. Attempt contact with Lupin on vehicle radios to advise them of the situation. Vehicles must be taken to high ground
2. A short wave radio is available that operates on a battery pack. (care must be taken to ensure the battery does not freeze in sub-zero temperatures). As well, the aviation radio is also available
3. Contact should be made with the Lupin weather station to advise the situation
