Re. 2BM-ULU2030 Part J Item 14 – Monthly Monitoring Program, SEPTEMBER

Further to Part J Item 14 of 2BM-ULU2030, Blue Star Gold Corp. (Blue Star) is pleased to provide the following in fulfillment of monthly monitoring requirements during periods of site activity. Ulu camp was shut down September 8th, with the environmental team demobilized September 4th. Camp operations were limited to shutting camp down for the season. No compliance monitoring samples were collected in September. Monitoring stations are listed in Table 1 and daily water use is provided in Table 2.
