Further to Part J Item 14 of 2BM-ULU2030, Blue Star Gold Corp. (Blue Star) is pleased to provide the following in fulfillment of monthly monitoring requirements during periods of site activity. Activities ongoing at Ulu Camp throughout July included camp operations, compliance monitoring, waste management, drilling, and exploration.
